






Subject Allocation Exercise: General Information



Features of Subject Allocation Exercise


- Students have to ensure they meet requirements for promotion to Sec 3 based on their overall results
 - Need to do well for all Weighted Assessments (WA)
- The overall results will be used for the purpose of subject allocation
- Merit-based placement
 - Final placement is based on students' merit, choice and available resources
 - Meeting the criteria is indicative of students' grasp of basic knowledge and skills to cope with the upper secondary subjects


How to make an appointment?
