1. Release of Term 2 Result Slips

2. New Timetable for Semester 2, 2022

3. School Attire / Hair & Grooming Checks on Mon, 27 Jun 2022 (first day of Term 3)

- Students can continue to wear half-school uniform (PE T-shirt and white school shorts/ pants/ skirt) to school.
- For girls, PE T-shirt or blouse need to be tucked in and skirts must be long enough to cover the knees.
- For boys, school shirt need to be tucked in and no tapered pants are allowed.
- Students should not tint/ dye/ bleach/ highlight their hair.
- Students are not allowed to put on any form of cosmetics, tattoo or body art such as henna.
- Students who do not meet required standards will be sent home to rectify their appearance and attire.

4. CCA Activities in Term 3, 2022

- Attendance of CCA is compulsory for your child/ward and it contributes to his/her progress under the LEAPS 2.0 Holistic Development Framework. We seek your support in ensuring that your child/ward attends and participates in the CCA.
- There will be CCAs on all Tuesdays except for the following 5 days i.e. 05 Jul, 19 Jul, 26 Jul, 09 Aug and 23 Aug in Term 3, 2022.
- For CCAs with competitions that require more sessions, the CCA teachers in-charge will issue letters to parents/guardians.

5. Enrichment/Special Programmes on Wednesday Afternoons in Term 3, 2022

- Attendance is compulsory for the planned programmes.
- The programme schedule can be found on the school website. For absenteeism, students are required to submit their medical certificate or parent letter to the respective teacher incharge of the programme.

7. Home-Based Learning (HBL) on Tue, 23 Aug and Wed, 24 Aug 2022

Students are required to <u>stay at home</u> and not report to school for the above stated period. Please take note of the following:

a. <u>Timetable</u>

- Follow the usual school timetable.
- b. Monitoring of Attendance and Student Learning
 - Form Teachers (FTs) will conduct daily online check-in with students by 7.50am.
 - Subject Teachers will monitor students' completion of online lessons and tasks as part of ongoing formative assessment.
 - As responsible learners, we trust students will follow the HBL schedule and complete their assigned tasks, including Student-Initiated Learning activities.
- c. Lesson Packages
 - Subject Teachers will upload school-based HBL packages onto Google Drive. These may include (i) online assignments; (ii) notes or worksheets; and (iii) references to hardcopy assignments such as textbooks or workbooks.
 - FTs will share the links through email, SLS or in class by Mon, 22 Aug 2022.
- d. Online Meeting Guidelines
 - Students are reminded that no revealing attire or inappropriate background to be used during any online teaching and learning meetings.
- e. Home-School Partnership during HBL days
 - Encourage your child/ward to pace their learning.
 - Check in with your child/ward to ensure they have completed their tasks.
 - Reduce number of distractions to create a conducive learning environment.
